Who: Maryland licensed Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnosis and Treatment (EPSDT) physicians and nurse practitioners.

What: **Fluoride Varnish and Oral Health Screening Training.** Beginning on July 1, 2009, the Maryland Medical Assistance Program will reimburse Maryland licensed physicians and nurse practitioners who are EPSDT medical providers and who are certified to participate in the Maryland Medicaid Program to apply fluoride varnish to children 9 months up to 3 years old as part of their scheduled well-child visit. Only those EPSDT medical providers who have received the approved state training in oral screening and the application of fluoride varnish are eligible to receive this reimbursement (up to 23% increase per well-child visit).
