

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED FOR PEDIATRIC NASAL SPRAY INFLUENZA VACCINE STUDY

The University of Maryland School of Medicine is recruiting healthy children to test an investigational vaccine for influenza (the "flu").

The study will require between 4-6 in-person clinic visits over up to 12 months. Participants in the study will get either one or two doses of the vaccine or placebo (salt water) by spray in the nose. Participants will receive the regular flu vaccine shot in the Fall of the year they receive the investigational. Participants will have three blood draws and three nasal washes over the course of the study.

Qualified Participants Must Be:

- ·6 months to 17 years old
- Generally healthy

Participants will receive up to \$625 in compensation. Study will be offered at Baltimore and Frederick locations.
