Developmental Surveillance: Using the TREEHOUSE Developmental Narrative for Observation

- YI (Young Infants): 0-6 months
- OI (Older Infants): 6-12 months
- YT (Young Toddlers): 12-18 months
- OT (Older Toddlers): 18-24 months

Communication:

- YI: vocalization (cooing/ babbling)
- OI: preverbal gestures ("hi", "bye", "pick me up", pointing)

YT: *verbalization:* receptive language and rudimentary expressive language (single words, jargoning)

OT: *verbalization*: exponential increase in expressive language (words and telegraphic speech)

Motor Development: Head to toe

- YI: Head, neck, upper extremities
- OI: Trunk and lower extremities
- YT/OT: Lower extremities

Cognitive: Learning and Play

- YI: does with_objects (mouthing)
- OI: does to objects (exploratory play- banging, shaking, dropping)
- YT: uses objects *functionally* (pop up toys, puzzles, stacking rings, blocks, crayons)

OT: uses objects *imaginatively* (dolls, cars, pretend play, dress ups)

Social Emotional: Attachment (Year 1)/ Separation, Exploration and Autonomy (Year 2)

YI: social smile/ laughing

- OI: stranger discrimination and stranger anxiety
- YT: shared joy (joint attention)/ separation anxiety/ exploration

OT: autonomy
